THANK YOU for considering RoofAdvisor

1. Initial Agreement: Before beginning any work for Customer, Company (RoofAdvisor) and Customer will agree on what trades will work on Customer's project and what specific tasks those trades will complete. Company's Scope of Work will be set forth in the signed Estimate. Company will make every effort to start work as quickly as possible following Customer's approval of work and acceptance thereof. All work will be performed in a workman-like and diligent manner. All EPA and OSHA rules and regulations will be followed during work. Company will ensure on-site supervision of all trades.

2. Agreed Price: The full amount of all monies specified in the agreed price does not include any change orders that might arise during the project that are not covered by the agreed price but which are necessary to complete the repair or replacement process as required by code for the building at issue. For services to be provided by Company that are covered by Insurance (Insurance Services), the Insurance Repair/Replace Contingency Agreement will supersede this agreement and bind the parties.

3. Access to Property: Customer agrees to provide Company access to Customer's property as necessary to begin and to complete the Scope of Work. Company shall not be responsible for damages arising from delays not caused by Company including but not limited to inclement weather, strikes, fire, accident or war. Customer also agrees to remove, store, and/or protect personal property during Company's work.

4. Job Completion: Job completion shall be the date on which Company's work is substantially finished (as distinguished from the date of customer's acceptance thereof) or the date of Company's last performance of Work at the property, whichever is earlier. Any instance of Customer failing to pay for any part of the Work shall release Company from any guaranty or warranty with respect to that component of the Work and all other components dependent thereon. Customer is entitled to "holdback" 5% of any specific trade estimate for punchlist items. Customer agrees to raise these items with Company after job completion. Any holdback will be paid in full on the date Company substantially completes the punchlist items.

5. Extra Material: Extra material may be delivered to jobsite to ensure timely completion of the Work. Any extra materials will be picked up and returned by Company to its supplier and will not be charged to Customer.

6. Payments: Customer shall make payments upon completion of each trade. Payments shall be made to the Company rather than to any individual.

7. Warranty: Company shall warrant workmanship and materials furnished and installed pursuant to this agreement consistent with materials warranties provided by particular manufacturers. If Company

is not paid in full in accordance with this agreement; all such warranties are null and void.

8. Past Due Amounts: Customer agrees to pay for all of Company's costs and reasonable attorneys' fees incurred in enforcing the terms of this Agreement.

9. Hazardous Materials: Nothing contained in this agreement shall be construed to require Company to determine the presence or absence of any hazardous material or asbestos-containing materials affecting the property or to require Company to remove or protect such materials. In the event that Company learns of the presence of such materials on Customer's property. Company reserves the right to immediately stop work, notify owner and negotiate a change order for such additional work as may be required by the presence of such materials.

10. Liability for Damages: Company is not responsible for damage or loss caused in whole or in part by: the acts or omissions of third parties, trades or contractors; lightning, winds, hailstorms, ice damage, hurricanes, tornadoes, floods, earthquakes or other unusual weather phenomena; structural settlement; failure, movement, cracking or excess deflection of the roof deck; defects or failure of materials used as roof decking, siding or gutters over which Company's material is applied; faulty chimneys, supports or other parts of the building; vapor condensation beneath the roof or siding; erosion, cracking and porosity of mortar and brick; dry rot; or other conditions beyond the control of Company; termites or other insects; rodents or other animals; fire; or harmful chemicals, oils, acids and the like that come in to contact with Customer's property and cause a leak or otherwise damage Customer's property; mold, algea, fungus, or mildew or depression or cracks in driveway caused by vehicles, trailers, dumpsters or delivery of materials; all interior damages including drywall cracking, nail pops, water spots. If Customer's property fails to maintain a watertight condition because of damage by reason of any of the foregoing, any applicable written warranty shall immediately become null and void for the balance of its term. The parties agree that COMPANY SHALL NOT BE LIABLE FOR ANY INCIDENTAL, INDIRECT, SPECIAL OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES OF ANY NATURE WHATSOEVER, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO LOSS OF ANTICIPATED PROFITS, OCCASIONED BY A BREACH OF ANY PROVISION OF THIS AGREEMENT EVEN IF APPRISED OF THE POSSIBILITY OF SUCH DAMAGES.

11. Future Damages: Contractor will make reasonable efforts to protect the property from any future damages. Contractor shall not, however, be held liable for wear and tear to driveways, parking lots, walkways, lawns, shrubs, or other floral or vegetation damage caused by truck, equipment, materials, workers, or debris as well as any damages to personal property or physical injury caused by vibrations sustained during the execution of work described in this agreement.

12. Property Release: Customer gives the Company permission to create and use content based upon Work done for Customer on Customer's property in any Media, for any purpose which may include, but not be limited to, advertising, promotion, marketing and packaging for any product or service. Customer agrees that the content may be combined with other content, text and graphics and cropped, altered or modified. Customer agrees that it has received adequate consideration for the rights granted in this release and acknowledges and agrees that it has no further right to additional consideration for Company's use of such material. Customer acknowledges and agrees that this release is binding upon its heirs and assigns and any person claiming an interest in the property. Customer agrees that this release is irrevocable, worldwide and perpetual, and will be governed by the laws (without consideration of conflicts of law analysis) of the state of Michigan. It is agreed that Customer's personal information will not be made publicly available but may only be used directly in relation to the licensing of the relevant content where necessary (e.g. to defend claims, protect rights or notify trade unions) and may be retained as long as necessary to fulfill this purpose, including being shared with sub-licensees and assignees of the Company and transferred to countries with differing data protection and privacy laws where it may be stored, accessed and used.

13. Outside Warranties: Customer understands all warranties that may apply to the Work, other than the Company's workmanship warranty, are those made by third parties. Customer shall not be entitled to recover from Company on any such warranty and agrees to pursue coverage directly with the manufacturer offering such warranty.

14. Limitation of Liability: Customer agrees that Customer's maximum recourse against Company under this agreement shall be limited to, the amount Customer has paid to Company for the Work. Customer understands and acknowledges that Company does not warrant or guarantee previous workmanship or preexisting materials. Company shall not be compelled to correct errors caused by others or the damages resulting therefrom.

15. Liens: Should default be made in payment of this agreement, a lien will be placed on the property for the amount owed and such amount shall accrue interest at the highest amount allowed by law from the date of substantial completion onward.

16. No Waiver: The failure of Company to enforce any provision of this agreement shall not be construed to be a waiver of such provisions or any breach, nor shall it affect the validity of this Agreement or any part of the Agreement or the right of the Company to enforce such provisions in any manner.

17. Entire Agreement: This agreement constitutes the entire agreement and understanding of Company and Customer relating to all of the subject matter hereof, and supersedes all prior agreements, arrangements, and understandings, written or oral between the parties concerning such subject matter.

PRE-LIEN NOTICE: COMPANY HEREBY PROVIDES NOTIFICATION THAT ANY PERSON OR COMPANY SUPPLYING LABOR OR MATERIALS FOR THIS IMPROVEMENT TO YOUR PROPERTY MAY FILE A LIEN AGAINST YOUR PROPERTY IF THAT PERSON OR COMPANY IS NOT PAID FOR SUCH CONTRIBUTIONS. CONTRACTOR NOTIFICATION: COMPANY HEREBY PROVIDES NOTIFICATION THAT AS OF THE DATE OF THIS AGREEMENT, COMPANY MAINTAINS PERSONAL INJURY LIABILITY INSURANCE. COMPANY ALSO HEREBY PROVIDES NOTIFICATION THAT WORKER'S COMPENSATION INSURANCE REQUIRED BY LAW HAS BEEN PROCURED PER STATE STATUTES. THE TERMS HEREOF ARE SPECIFICALLY AGREED TO AND INCORPORATED HEREIN.
